

What do I do if I am a...

Contract Worker working at a TransGrid Project WSAT (Premium)

If you work for a company that contracts to TransGrid, you must be registered in the WSAT system as a worker. Your registration is typically completed by your company on your behalf. You will have a profile in the system where your qualifications, competencies (licenses, tickets, records etc.) training history will be recorded.

If a TransGrid project is being supported by the WSAT (premium) to manage site inductions and site attendance (you can find a list of project [here](#)) there are additional things you need to be aware of.

01

Ensure you have been registered in WSAT and assigned to a TransGrid project, by speaking your Contract Administrator or TransGrid Site Rep.

Once registered, you will receive an email asking you to complete an online TransGrid site induction, prior to coming to site.



03

At the completion of your online induction, you'll be able to notify a TransGrid Site Rep via email, that you are coming to site to finalise your induction & start work



04

On your first day on site, complete a site familiarisation, sign-off with a TransGrid Site Rep and any other inductions required by the Project.

Use your Pegasus ID Card to sign in/out of site each day against the kiosk and remember to carry your ID card at all times
